is the author of more than sixty books and widely known for his ability to combine Celtic and other mythology with urban fiction, typified in his Newford series. *Little (Grrl) Lost* is his recent young adult novel.

Robert Sawyer (Can)

has been called the dean of Canadian science fiction and is one of Canada's best-known writers. *Rollback* is a near-future novel about contact with alien intelligences and, in classic Sawyer style, presents likable characters facing moral dilemmas.



Tom Wayman (Can)

provides a tour of his influential poetry in *High Speed Through Shoaling Water*, a fable-like guide to the Kootenays in *Boundary Country*, and a wildly creative portrait of human vanity in *A Vain Thing*.
